The Bladen County Water District has tested strategic wells near the Chemours Facility and the Cape Fear River.

Gen-X was found to be present in the Tobermory Well, The Live Oak Well and the White Oak water system at a minimal detect level of 11 parts per trillion.

The NCDEQ and NCDHHS have established 140 parts per trillion as the threshold level to be of cause for health concern.

Based on the information provided by the NCDEQ and the NCDHHS we have good confidence that the water provided by the Bladen County Water District is safe for human consumption.
