Indoor Batting Cage Attendant (Two Vacancies)

The Indoor Batting Cage Attendant will be responsible for supervising the indoor batting cages during operating hours. Attendant must know and enforce rules, policies and procedures. Must make sure all doors are locked and all people are gone from the indoor facility before leaving. Responsible for general cleanliness of the cages and building during operating hours and making sure the cages and building is clean after the cages close. Attendant will be responsible for collecting user fees for the indoor facility and turning in the fees to the Recreation Department.

Requirements:

Must be at least 16 years of age. Attend scheduled staff meetings. Ability to lift and move objects including basket of softballs/baseballs and equipment. Strong communication skills and organizational skills. Ability to work diligently and conscientiously when working with work schedules. **Ability to work efficiently and courteously with the public.**
